

Request for Delivery of Specific Notices by E-mail

Per Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 1.086, “on the written request of the owner of a residential property that is occupied by the owner as the owner’s principal residence, the chief appraiser of the appraisal district in which the property is located shall send each notice required by this title . . . to the e-mail address of the owner.”

Documents included in this section include:

- A change in value of the property,
- The eligibility of the property for an exemption, or
- The grant, denial, cancellation, or other change in the status of an exemption or exemption application applicable to the property.

*****Please note that if delivery of these notices by e-mail is chosen, the chief appraiser is not required to mail that same notice to the property owner. Furthermore, this request remains in effect, until revoked in writing by the property owner.**

If the e-mail address changes, it will be the responsibility of the property owner to notify the appraisal district of the change.
